## **Content Manager Version 4.4.0 (for Mac)**

## [About Content Manager]

- Content Manager is a content-management system designed for the Optical Disc Archive System (ODS).

# [Important Notice]

- Content Manager 4.4.0 supports Optical Disc Archive Software Version 5.5.1.
  - Any earlier version than Optical Disc Archive Software 5.5.1 does not support Content Manager 4.4.0.
  - Please upgrade your current Optical Disc Archive Software to version 5.5.1.
- Content Manager doesn't support Mac product with Apple silicon.

## [Main Function of Content Manager]

- Archiving audio-visual materials to shelf-managed Optical Disc Cartridges (ODCs).
- Searching and retrieving archived contents.
- Browsing and searching with online proxy video and thumbnails for shelf-managed ODCs.<sup>i</sup>
- Advanced search using face-recognition data.<sup>ii</sup>

### [Main changes in v4.4]

 Added a function "JSON file output" to the archive/view pull-down menu to output metadata of all files in the cartridge.
 [Note] When outputting a file archived to a cartridge using Optical Disc Archive Filer,

Please execute after copying all files in the cartridge to the destination folder.

- Improved past archive progress information did not reach 100% during DB restore.
- Improved the log with the driver branch number was not obtained when obtaining the log.
- Improved the display of progress rate during compression during DB backup.
- Improved so that network drives are not displayed as DB regular backup destination.
- Fixed an issue where an error would be displayed if CatalystBrowse was installed but not.

### [Notes on upgrades]

- Please make a backup of your database before the upgrade.
- When you install V4.4.0 over the previous version, the database and metadata created on the previous version are automatically converted into V4.4.0 format.
  - The installation may take a long time when the size of metadata is large.
  - You cannot install V4.4.0 over V1.0.0. Please install V3.1.5 over V1.0.0 before installing V4.4.0.
  - Please do not access the database and metadata folder during the installation.
  - Please do not shut down the computer during the installation.

 Even when you uninstall the previous version, before installing V4.4.0, database and metadata created on the older version are automatically migrated.

- When you uninstall the previous version completely, the database and metadata are deleted.
- The installation may take a long time when the size of metadata is large.
- Please do not shut down the computer during the installation.
- When you perform V4.4.0 update and then restore the backup data made on the previous version, the database and metadata created on the previous version are automatically converted into V4.4.0 format.
  - Restoring data may take a long time when the size of metadata is large.
- Database and metadata created on V4.4.0 cannot be used on the previous version.

- Backup data created on V4.4.0 cannot be used on the previous version.

- Please download the installer.
  - The installer is provided as a disk image "ContentManager\_4\_4\_0\_mac.zip"
- <Step>
- To start the installer of Content Manager, please double-click the package in the disk image and proceed with the installation according to the instructions.

Note:

If Java is not installed, please double-click the package to install Java.

<Activation>

- Authentication is required to use Content Manager.
  - Please use the serial number that comes with the ODA unit.
  - One serial number is supplied with each ODA Unit.
  - A serial number can be used to activate Content Manager on a single computer.
  - To obtain additional licenses, please purchase serial number(s) from the Sony professional product site.

# [Note on Use]

- 1. About this application
  - Archiving to a device other than the ODC is not possible with Content Manager.
  - When you perform operations on files managed by this application on Mac Finder or Windows Explorer, you may not be able to operate them successfully with this application.
    - 1. Please do not perform operations on a metadata folder or a cache folder on Mac Finder or Windows Explorer.
  - If a web-service-based application other than Content Manager has been installed, Content Manager may not function properly.
  - While Content Manager is running, Optical Disc Archive Filer included with Optical Disc Archive Software cannot be launched. Terminate Content Manager service first, and then start Optical Disc Archive Filer.
  - This application may not work properly when you use this application on Mac from another Windows computer over a network and vice versa.
  - When less space than 3GB is left on a volume or device used with this application, this application may stop the system for the sake of safe operations. In that case, please increase the free space and operate again.
- 2. About installation
  - Please do not shut down the computer during the installation.

- When text-input does not work properly while attempting Activation, please restart the computer or log in again, and then try again Activation.
- The existing database and metadata can be used even after a new installation, unless you
  do not delete the database by uninstalling the application completely.
- If a warning message is displayed and you cannot install, this application may be blocked.
   If this application is blocked, you can unblock it by following the steps below.
  - 1. Select [System Preferences] > [Security & Privacy] from the Apple menu.
  - 2. Select [General] tab and make sure Content Manager.app is blocked at the bottom.
  - 3. Click the [Open Anyway] button.
  - 4. If a warning message is displayed, click the [Open] button.

The Content Manager installation dialog is displayed, so continue the installation.

- 3. About network settings
  - This application could be accessed by any unintended third party on the network, depending on a usage environment. Please connect to a secure network.
  - If you use a proxy server in a Local Area Network (LAN), please bypass the proxy server for local addresses.
    - 1. In "System Preference > Network > Advanced > Proxies"
      - Please add "localhost\*" to the host and domain that do not use proxies.
  - Depending on the status of the network connections and the setting of the local loopback address, there is a possibility of misjudgment as other computers. If you are accessing from own computer and there are limitations on the operations that can be used, please make sure that the local loopback address is properly set.
  - This application may not work properly depending on the status of network connections.
- 4. About Web Browser
  - Safari cannot play WebM proxy video.
  - With Chrome, you will not be able to view XML files generated by the file list export function.
  - With Safari Ver6.0.1 or later, you will not be able to view XML files generated by the file list export function.

(In "Safari > Preferences > Advanced", by checking "development menu on the menu bar" and by checking "Development > Disable the limitation of local file viewing" you will be able to view the XML file)

- Safari cannot include surrogate pair characters or combining characters in the file name of catalog data exported in csv format.
- The application may not function properly depending on extensions installed on Chrome.
- This application may not work properly depending on the browsing history. If this is the case, please delete the browsing history and restart this application.
- It is recommended to use the latest version of Web Browser.
- 5. About video processing
  - Depending on application software on which files are created, you may not be able to successfully generate proxy video, thumbnails, and face/speech metadata for some files even if they are in a supported format.
  - You may not be able to successfully generate proxy video, thumbnails and face metadata for a video file without audio or an audio-only file, even if it is a supported format.

- The audio of proxy video is generated from 1 ch and 2 ch of the original material. Audio of other channels will not be included in the proxy video.
- Depending on the performance of the computer, you may not be able to successfully generate proxy video, thumbnails, and face/speech metadata.
- When processing unsupported video files, an error message dialog may appear. In that case, please close the message dialog and continue the operation.
- 6. About Catalyst Browse
  - Please install Catalyst Browse separately in order to play archived files on cartridge from File Details Dialog.
    - 1. Please download the installer from Sony Creative Software website. (<u>http://www.sonycreativesoftware.com/catalystbrowse</u>)
  - Please refer to the Help of Catalyst Browse for the usage and supported video format.
  - Content Manager cannot lauch Catalyst Browse when you are excluding the install location of Catalyst Browse from Spotlight Search targets.
- 7. About label printing
  - Please set the margin to zero (none), and turn off the header and footer when printing.
- 8. About file list export
  - CSV files may get garbled depending on the application which open CSV files.
- 9. About Exporting a catalog data
  - Some characters of file name for export files may be converted to other characters.
- 10. About Watched Folder Archive
  - Please do not select a folder on a write-protected drive or XDCAM.
  - Files created in the watched folder will be deleted after completion of archive.
  - Folders created in the watched folder will not be deleted automatically after completion of archive. They need to be deleted manually.
  - Read-only files created under the watched folder cannot be archived.
- 11. About Backup, Restore, Export and Import
  - Data backed up on Windows cannot be used on Mac and vice versa.
  - Data exported on Windows cannot be imported on Mac and vice versa.
  - Backup may take a long time when the size of metadata is large.
  - Before performing the backup, free space whose size is equivalent to the one of the metadata is required to the destination of the backup. Additionally, the free space whose size is double size of the one of the metadata is required to the drive in the destination of the installation.
  - Restore may take a long time when the size of the backup data.
  - Database update may be necessary after restoring the database or importing the exported database.
  - Please do not exit this application while restoring data. When you exit this application while restoring data, please restart the computer.

- Please do not shut down the computer while restoring data. When the computer shuts down while restoring data, please uninstall completely and re-install this application, and then restore the data again.
- Please do not access the database and metadata folder while restoring data.
- Backup function may not work properly while extracting metadata.
- Please do not shut down the computer while importing.
- 12. About Notification Settings

#### 13. About the administrator password

- If you forget your password, the password can be reissued to the e-mail address registered to themail notification settings.
- If mail notification setting has not been made, please reinstall Content Manager after performing a complete uninstallation.
   (Please note that the metadata and the database are deleted by uninstalling the

application completely.)

#### 14. About external devices

- Only the local HDD/SSD of the PC connected to the ODA drive is supported as the automatic backup destination for the DB of this application. If you use the network drive as the automatic DB backup destination, this application may not work properly.
- This application is designed and evaluated on the premise of archiving from and retrieving to the local HDD/SSD of a PC connected to an ODA drive. Therefore, if you use the network drive for archiving or retrieving, this application may not work properly.
- When you perform archive from a network drive, ODC or XDCAM without using the cache, you cannot copy data to your local computer simultaneously while archiving.
- Please do not set a network drive, a write-protected drive, ODC or XDCAM drives as a cache folder, a metadata folder, a backup folder, or a destination of "Copy to local disk".
- When you retrieve data to XDCAM, the retrieve may be failed because the file format may be changed automatically. In that case, please uncheck "Enable strict file compare when retrieving", and then retrieve the data to XDCAM.

### 15. About uninstallation

- You can uninstall this application in two different ways:
  - 1. Uninstall the software by the uninstaller that comes with the installer
  - 2. Completely unistall the software (uninstall the software and delete all data)
- Database and metadata generated by this application will not be deleted even if you
  uninstall the application by the uninstaller that comes with the installer.
- When you uninstall this application completely, the database and metadata created on this application will be deleted.
- Please contact our service representatives for a complete uninstallation.
- 16. About the server certificate required to set HTTPS communication

- Please use the server certificate issued by the public certificate authority.
- Self-signed certificates cannot be used.
- 17. About changing the metadata folder
  - If you try to change the metadata folder to a non-empty folder, you cannot change it. In that case, select another empty folder, or move or delete the files in the folder to make it an empty folder, and then set the metadata folder again.
- 18. Others
  - Please restart the computer whenever you change your computer's time or time zone.
  - The folders including inaccessible folders or files may not be archived properly.
  - This application may not work properly when the computer goes to a sleep status.
  - When a filepath is too long, the file may not be displayed on UI or its metadata may not be extracted.
  - When too many files or folders are requested for archive, retrieve or extraction of metadata all at once, this application may not register the jobs properly or display the list of jobs properly depending on the performance of the computer or the status of the network.
  - When too many files or folders are added to the Placeholder, this application may not add the files or folders properly depending on the performance of the computer or the status of the network.
  - Double quotation marks (") can be used in the metadata but they cannot be used in a text search.
  - The cartridge is displayed in the desktop area of the archive screen, but it cannot be operated.
